Dear Members and Friends of Prince of Peace:

Wikipedia defines a “snow day” as a “weather-related cancellation or delay is when an institution, operation, or event is closed, canceled, or delayed as a result of inclement weather conditions . . . Depending upon the local climate, the chances of a closing may vary.”. Here in the Delaware Valley it’s fair to say that we have had our fair share of snow days. The good news is that we are less than three weeks away from Spring. The bad news is that while *Prince of Peace* never did close, we did cancel some services which means we are behind on our giving commitment for 2010.

To that end we have designated the **month of March** as a time to review your giving commitment and to resolve any differences between your Estimate of Giving and actual. This is an especially appropriate time for this consideration as it is the Lenten season, a time of preparation through prayer, penitence, fasting and almsgiving. Do so knowing that *Stewardship* is about *raising disciples*. It’s about giving out of Christian love rather than a sense of duty:

“Lord, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or needing clothes or sick or in prison, and did not help you? He will reply, I tell you the truth, whatever you did not do for one of the least of these, you did not do for me”. *Matthew 25: 44-45*

Thank you again for your many gifts (time, talents and treasure) to God’s work .We are God’s presence on earth as we reach out to each other and to our community.
